## **SOCAMATYC Annual Meeting Minutes**

Jennifer Aull – SOCAMATYC President called the meeting to order 1:35 AM.

Item 1: Announcement that Kim Neal – SOCAMTYC Treasurer and Greg Colley – SOCAMATYC Secretary will be stepping down from their offices at the next conference after serving in these rolls for 12 years. A normal term is two years so they have served six consecutive terms and feel it is time for new officers in these roles.

Item 2: Dr. Alvina J. Atkinson the Southeast VP for AMATYC spoke to the members about the AMATYC conference being in Atlanta, GA November 14 – 17, 2024. Everyone was reminded that SOCAMATYC will pay for one person's registration to the AMATYC Conference. Anyone interested should submit their name to one of the SOCAMATC officers for a random drawing sometime in July 2024. A non-member registration is \$601 and an AMATYC member registration is \$475.

Item 3: Kim Neal gave the treasury report. After the 2024 conference expenses, we have \$2639.49 in the budget. Since our membership and registrations are our only source of revenue it was discussed that enrollment has declined and all need to speak to their fellow math faculty about becoming members and attending the conference.

Item 4: The location and the date of the next conference was discussed. A tentative date of February 28 – March 1, 2024 was chosen. These dates will be vetted before a final decision is made on this week. It was discussed that bringing back the Friday night presentation followed by a social event might improve attendance to the conference. Several colleges were discussed for the next conference focusing on the colleges that had never hosted SOCAMATYC. The choices in order are below depending on the desire of that college to host. 1) Horry- Georgetown 2) Orangeburg-Calhoun 3) Tri-County, and 4) Spartanburg. The representatives at the meeting from Tri-County Technical College stated they would host if the first two colleges were not interested, and we appreciate their willingness to host the conference.

Item 5: Drawing was held for door prizes. Due to low participation in the joint North Carolina/South Carolina Conference all participants at the meeting received a prize.

Call for any new business did not result in additional topics.
